Programme description	<p>The course of geography has a long tradition at the University of Lodz as the first geographical unit was created along with the University foundation.</p> <p>Geography is an interdisciplinary course of study which reflects the diversity of research subjects within the discipline.</p> <p>The MA programme is designed to equip undergraduates with all necessary skills and knowledge required to understand and manage contemporary problems of physical and human environments at all scales. Geography at the University of Lodz involves undergraduates in a wide range of lectures, practical classes and fieldwork, which altogether contribute to their multidimensional education.</p> <p>Undergraduates are entitled to apply to most graduate courses offered in Poland and abroad. At the same time they become competent and skilled workers in many sectors such as: spatial planning, environment monitoring and protection, tourism, public offices or education.</p>
Tuition	2500 EUR/year for students from outside the EU/EFTA, exclusive of an additional 200 EUR charge that covers registration fee (for students of Polish origin the tuition is reduced by 30%).
Deadline for application	July 15, 2015
Requirements	Candidates holding higher education (Bachelor) diplomas or Master degrees may apply. A transcript of records showing the subjects/grades and a certificate of proficiency in English for foreigners (unless the first degree was taught in English) are required.
