<b>Programme description</b>	<p>Asian Studies is a special program embodied into the International Studies framework. Apart from obligatory courses (600 hours) we offer special classes dedicated to the field of Asian Studies – more than 1200 hours. Apart from Chinese and Japanese languages and basic Hindi language we mainly teach political, social and economic development of East Asian countries.</p> <p>You will acquire the knowledge in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Chinese and Japanese languages and cultural heritage and Introduction to Hindi language;</li><li>• East and South Asia politics: political systems of China, Taiwan, Japan, the Korean Peninsula, and South East Asian countries;</li><li>• East and South Asia social development: social changes and challenges across the region with special regards to poverty alleviation and migration;</li><li>• East and South Asia international politics: major players include the United States, China, Japan, South and North Korea, Russia, and South East Asian countries;</li></ul>
