The focus is on practical skills obtained during specialization courses.</p> <p>Basic objectives of the studies include gaining the following knowledge and skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – theory and research methods of political science, with the ability to use them for analyzing, modeling and forecasting political processes, in connection with economic and social phenomena; – the ability to analyze the activity of state and international institutions; – putting the knowledge to practical use, e.g. as team leaders in the public organizations and institutions <p>The graduates of Political Science will be qualified to work at, among others:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – state and local government institutions, dealing with both internal and foreign policy – international organizations and institutions – companies trading internationally – state institutions and political organizations participating in the transformation of political systems
