Programme description	<p>The interfaculty Master's degree course '<i>Spatial Development and Planning</i>' is run by the Faculty of Geographical Sciences and the Faculty of Management. It offers specialist knowledge in the field of sustainable planning of cities and regions and shaping the environment in accordance with human needs, technical possibilities and the principles of spatial order and environment protection. The program of study is focused on spatial problems in urbanized areas and ways of resolving them. It emphasizes the importance of public spaces in the functioning of cities and the role of cultural heritage in their unique character and identity. Students analyse the determinants, processes and effects of spatial development in close connection with the practice of making the planning decisions. The studies improve the ability to use computer software supporting the process of spatial planning.</p> <p>The course leads to a Master's degree. Graduates possess knowledge, skills and competences necessary in the process of planning and designing urban space, formulating the principles of spatial and environmental policy at all levels of management, and making rational decisions concerning the management of the city and region and the shaping of space according to sustainable development principles. Graduates also have skills useful in resolving spatial conflicts, and are able to evaluate correctly and prioritize</p>

	<p>various social, economic and ecological objectives.</p> <p>Graduates are prepared to undertake work in local government, urban planning and design, public administration, local and regional development agencies, academic institutions, real estate agencies and as geodesy and cartography specialists. A few years' practice will enable graduates to perform management functions in the above-mentioned professions and institutions.</p>
Tuition	2500 EUR/year for students from outside the EU/EFTA, exclusive of an additional 120 EUR charge that covers registration fee (for students of Polish origin the tuition is reduced by 50%).

Requirements	Candidates holding higher education (Bachelor) diplomas or Master degrees may apply. A transcript of records showing the subjects/grades and a certificate of proficiency in English for foreigners (unless the first degree was taught in English) are required.
